

JHF and the World Bank concluded MOU to jointly promote green housing finance

Japan Housing Finance Agency (“JHF”) and the World Bank* concluded the Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) to foster cooperation on housing finance to facilitate construction of energy efficient houses, so called green housing finance, in Asian countries and the MOU signing ceremony was held in Washington D.C., U.S.A., on June 17, 2019.

For both JHF and the World Bank, this MOU is the first MOU to focus on promotion of green housing finance, therefore, JHF will continue to foster global awareness of JHF’s effort to facilitate construction of energy efficient houses in cooperation with the World Bank.
