

JHF delivered a lecture at the JICA training program on “Improvement and Disaster Prevention of Housing and Living Environment”

Japan Housing Finance Agency (“JHF”) delivered a lecture on development of the housing finance system at Knowledge Co-Creation Program (Group & Region Focus) on “Improvement and Disaster Prevention of Housing and Living Environment” of Japan International Cooperation Agency (“JICA”) for the officials of governments, local governments and governmental organizations involved in the planning of policies and systems for improvement of housing and living environment on October 23, 2018 in Tokyo, Japan.

In this program, JICA invited government officials from developing countries to improve planning and performance ability of policy-makers in national governments, local governments and governmental organizations that oversee the improvement policy of housing and living environments in those countries. A lecturer from JHF introduced housing loan products, interest rate setting, quality housing promotion, inspection of construction, collaboration with the private sector, etc, which have been implemented in accordance with the government’s housing policies since the time of JHF’s former organization, the Government Housing Loan Corporation, to the present time.
